## DESCRIPTION

MultiView Mascot is a product developed by JSB Computer Systems Limited and sold under Digital Equipment Corporation's standard Terms and Conditions.

MultiView Mascot is a windowing environment for character-based terminals. The Mascot user-interface is compliant with the Motif® guidelines developed by the Open Software Foundation<sup>™</sup>. MultiView Mascot maximizes the limited resources of character-based terminals to enable the user to run up to six applications simultaneously.

The MultiView Mascot user-interface is an option to be used with applications running in a plain UNIX® environment without the need of adapting UNIX or the application(s).

The main parts of MultiView Mascot are:

- The UNIX manager, which enables non-technical users to perform complex UNIX system administration tasks. Since the UNIX manager is totally configurable, only those menu functions required by the individual user need to be configured onto that user's menu.
- The windowing environment with functions such as create, select, move, size, switch, minimize and maximize windows as well as copy and paste between windows on screen. Windows can be tiled, overlapped, or iconized, depending on the taste and needs of the user.
- The adaptable menu structure and hierarchy makes it possible to customize MultiView Mascot to the needs and demands of each individual user. For each user you can decide which application may be run, which window functionality may be used, and even change the style of the prompts and messages.
- The virtual terminal, which provides the link between terminal and application without modification of the application.
