

Read Before Installing or Using HP BASIC Version 1.7 for OpenVMS Alpha Systems

April 2007

This release is a maintenance update of HP BASIC for OpenVMS Alpha. It is identical to HP BASIC for OpenVMS I64 systems except for a few platform-dependent exceptions. These differences are noted in the accompanying release notes.

License Management Facility Information

To install HP BASIC Version 1.7 for OpenVMS Alpha Systems, you must first register a License Product Authorization Key (license PAK) using the License Management Facility (LMF). See the *HP BASIC for OpenVMS Alpha Systems Installation Guide* for licensing instructions.
