



## ***Read Before Installing HP OPC Transport for OpenVMS Integrity servers V1.0***

### ***SOFTWARE INFORMATION***

HP is pleased to announce OPC Transport for OpenVMS Integrity servers V1.0 release. OPC Transport is supported by HP, only for use in OPC environments and is a subset of COM. Only unauthenticated COM is supported.

### ***License Information***

OPC Transport for OpenVMS Integrity servers is licensed with the OpenVMS Foundation Operating Environment (FOE) on Integrity.

### ***Installation Information***

Installing OPC Transport V1.0 requires the following:

- For OpenVMS systems
  - OpenVMS Integrity servers V8.2-1 or higher
  - For Windows 2000 Interoperability:  
The most recent DCE\$LIB\_SHR.EXE (available from your support center)
  - For OPC Transport for OpenVMS application development:  
Recommended: HP C++ V7.2 or higher  
Minimum requirement: HP C++ V7.2 or higher
  - /STANDARD=RELAXED  
The C++ compiler supports many different compilation standards. HP recommends to use /STANDARD=RELAXED.
  - To build ATL applications on OpenVMS:  
HP C++ V7.2 or higher

- HP TCP/IP Services for OpenVMS V5.6
- For Windows Systems:
  - Windows NT 4.0 with Service Pack 5 or higher
  - OR
  - Windows 2000 with Service Pack 4 or higher
  - Microsoft Visual C++ or Visual Basic (for Windows client development and information about MIDL compiler). See the Microsoft website for compiler version requirements.
  - TCP/IP enabled (needed for OpenVMS connectivity)

To install OPC Transport, invoke the POLYCENTER Software Installation utility using the following command:

```
$ PRODUCT INSTALL OPC_TRANSPORT /SOURCE=device:[directory]
```

For *device:[directory]*, specify the device name and directory location of the kit, respectively.

After installing OPC Transport, the Installation Guide and Release Notes document is located in:

```
SYS$HELP:OPC_INSTALL_RN.TXT
```
